



A Major Scale – The Bell Tone Scale


Your fourth finger changes into a carpenter and pounds on the A string with a heavy hammer.

Stop before playing the fourth finger and be careful to place it roundly on the A string. Does it look right? Now you can continue playing.







Image: Constant Songs with the Third Finger Pattern Image: Constant Songs with the Third









Roller Coaster Songs with the Fourth Finger Pattern



The Rapid Passage in Gossec, Gavotte





We already want to begin preparatory work on a passage from the last piece in this book:

1st Step: Play very slowly with separated strokes and insert a stop before the 4th finger.

		high		Stop!	low			
A 1	3	2	3	Lift the 2nd finger, then place the 4th finger!	4	3	2	1

2nd Step: Now play a little faster. Bow four staccato strokes in the same direction and stop before the 4th finger.
3rd Step: The tempo stays the same. Now slur four notes.

The high third finger on the G string appears frequently in this spirited song. You will need to play this note in the "Gavotte" as well.

Start this song slowly and increase the tempo with each repetition.
